THE LAST FACE-TO-FACE MEETING

On September 26th, the OPEN4U consortium held their final Transnational Project Meeting in Naples, Italy, hosted by the project coordinator, Fondazione IFEL Campania.

With the project scheduled to conclude by the end of November, the meeting focused on reviewing the project timeline and evaluating the status of each work package. Key discussions focused on assessing deliverable completion, planning the remaining tasks, and organizing the final steps toward project closure, with a particular focus on finalizing the project app and preparing local conferences to promote its outcomes. The consortium also reviewed dissemination activities and conducted a quality evaluation.

OPEN4U MOBILE APP STATUS

Following the internal testing by the partners' staff, the consortium has now moved on to external testing, involving 30 SME staff members per country (15 junior and 15 senior employees). These participants are testing the app and will complete a feedback questionnaire at the end of the process. Based on this feedback, any technically relevant suggestions will be incorporated, leading to the final version of the app.
